With more than 2,948 exhibitors from 80 countries and global brands displayed across 21 halls of food tech, Gulfood Manufacturing is divided into various sectors, offering an all-inclusive range of products and services, from ingredients to processing and packaging technology. In the processing and packaging technologies category, **E80 Group plays a leading role at stand C2-42 hall 2**.

Gulfood Manufacturing has grown significantly, being 40% larger than in previous years, with 25% of exhibitors being new to the show. E80 Group's continuous growth is evident, with its revenue rising from 238 million euros in 2017 to 389 million euros in 2022. The company is poised to reach 550 million euros in revenue in 2023, 20% of which is anticipated to be generated in the food industry. Noteworthy European and international clients include NFPC, Barilla, Unilever, Carozzi, Abafoods, and many others.
