Revv Up is a free-of-equity-or-cost acceleration program by T-AIM that is exclusively designed for early-stage AI startups. Among other interventions, the program offers exclusive opportunities for AI startups to interact with the government and industry.

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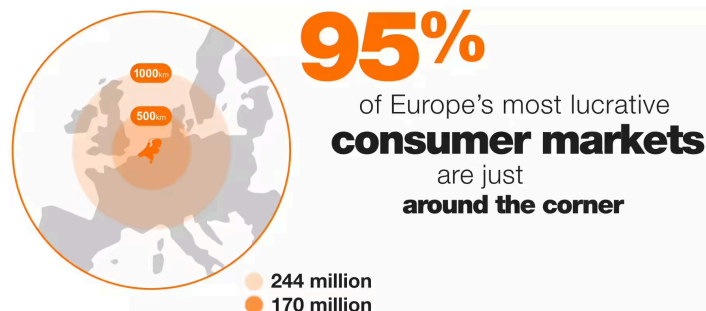
The Triple Helix

This framework unites business, government, and academia to co-create solutions that address real-world challenges. Knowledge institutions fuel research and expertise, the government supports with favorable policies and businesses bring commercial viability.

Companies benefit by gaining access to world-class knowledge clusters – such as science and innovation parks – with R&D facilities, abundant talent and other industry leaders.
